## *Sámi Siida: Reindeer Park & Sámi Camp*

*Visitor centre outdoors with turf hut, tents and storage stands from the nomadic life as well as exhibits about recent life. In the corral you meet our tamed reindeer. Take the opportunity to feed and photograph a reindeer. We have a handicraft shop, a café and a reception for our eco adventures.*

### **Sámi visitor centre with reindeer**

At Sámi Siida you can get to know something of our history and our traditions as a nomadic people. We will show you how we lived in the past and how we live to this day. Sámi Siida is an experience for young and old, where you can get a taste of an exotic culture and learn more about one of the world's indigenous people – the Sámi. You can also meet our friend the reindeer and have an opportunity to get really close. We will tell you about the reindeer, how they live, what they eat and talk about the myths and magic that surround them. You can learn more about how reindeer herding is done and you can try throwing the lasso at reindeer horns.

### **Sámi handicraft shop & reception**

Inside the octagon wooden building there is a crafts section and shop where you can see our traditional craftsmanship, largely using materials like reindeer horn and reindeer leather. There is a range of traditional- and modern Sámi handicraft and souvenirs for sale.

You can get informed about our Sámi eco adventures, including guided hiking tours in the mountains and accommodation (cabins & lávvu-tents) at our camp Reindeer Lodge, and book at the spot.

### **Café Sápmi**

Inside the giant Sámi tent you can settle down, enjoy the open fire and have a cup of coffee with a cake or a light meal.
